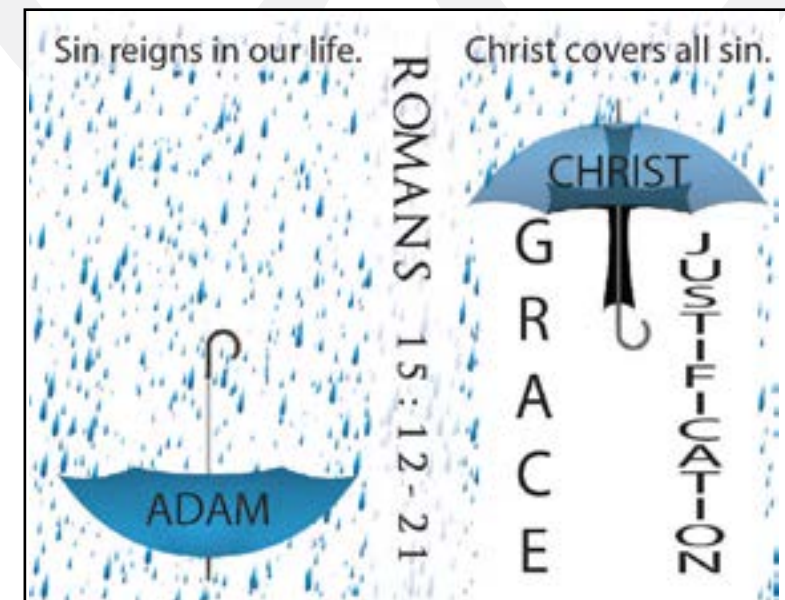
RIPPLE KIDZ CHILDRENS MINISTRY

Within the last four weeks, we have helped 8 families with a total 29 families since last fall. This month, we delivered clothing for several families, kitchen and cooking utensils, bedding, 2 twin beds, 2 mattresses for bunk beds, a washer/ dryer set, 3 queen beds, one dresser, two chest of drawers, dining room table and chairs, 2 couches, and a portacrib. For one family, a mother and two teenage daughters, we helped them move from a one room efficiency to a three bedroom apartment. We supplied three bedrooms, a living room and kitchen supplies for this family. The generosity of so many of you has been a blessing to these families. May God receive all of the praise and the glory! Please be in prayer for the families we serve, that we may shine the light of Jesus in their lives and encourage them in their efforts to learn how to stand on their own.

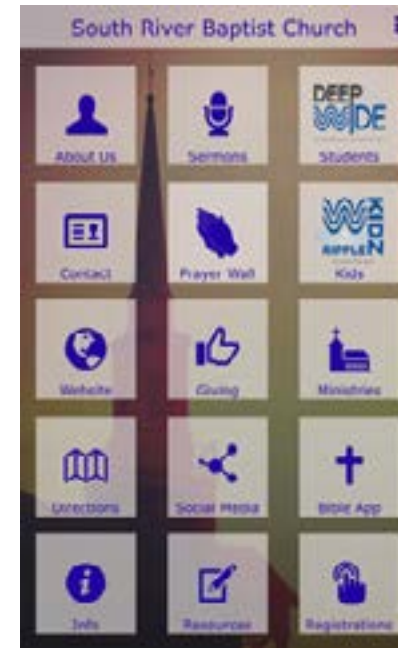

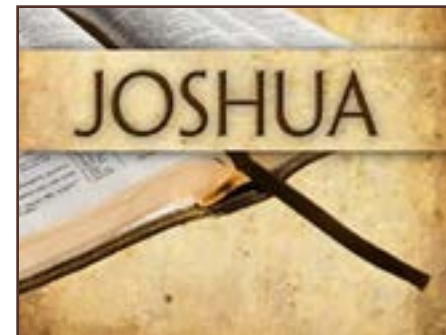
