


MISSIONS WAREHOUSE



South River continues to minister to our community and county in phenomenal ways. We do not envision any reduction in our efforts as our culture is negatively impacted economically and spiritually. Our church is in desperate need for adequate space to house many of our bulk resources, trailers, vehicles, and food supplies. Currently, we store material in 3 major locations both on and off site. The purpose of the mission's warehouse is to provide the following:

- Multiple storage racks for equipment, relief supplies, appliances, and furniture
- Designated area for food storage and walk-in cooler
- Designated building and construction area for small projects
- · Housing location for 3 buses, 2 vans, multiple trailers and automotive type service bay
- Covered loading dock areas to facilitate possible distribution of relief supplies
- Small conference room and planning area for mission teams

Outside, the warehouse will be a graveled area that will provide additional parking for events on future ball fields and other major ministry events.

NEXT STEPS

We believe South River is poised to make the next decisions to begin fulfilling the 20-year Field of Faith vision:

- Decide to launch Headwaters Academy in August 2021 as ministry of South River Baptist Church.
- Decide to begin grading new parking lot area to houses modular units for Headwaters Academy.
- Decide to purchase modular units for grades K-2 of Headwaters Academy.
- Decide to identify and hire architect to develop plans for first buildings.
- · Authorize civil engineer to develop entry boulevard, graveled parking area, and initial location of mobile units and future planning for school area, FLC addition, and mission's warehouse area.

OVERVIEW

The Pastoral Leadership and the Strategic Vision Ministry team are pleased to present Phase 1 of the Field of Faith Vision. Following is a summary of critical elements we believe God is leading South River to initiate in this phase of the 20-year vision. There are three major elements of this first phase: launching Headwaters Academy, renovating and expanding the Family Life Center, and building the Missions Warehouse.

We believe that the launch of Headwaters Academy is a critical first component to fulfilling this vision. We stand amazed at what God has accomplished in the past year through the launch of the Headwaters Educational Enrichment ministry. The growth and awareness of our commitment to educate the next generation grounding them in God's truth has fueled other ministries at South River. There has been incredible growth in our ministries over the past year not only in numbers but also in spiritual affect. This attendance increase will necessitate the renovation and addition to the Family Center sooner than we thought. Further, our ministry efforts throughout our community have increased steadily because of the greater needs resulting from government imposed shutdowns and the loss of livelihoods. This is the time for the church to become more engaged in our community!


HEADWATERS ACADEMY


What began as a ministry of educational enrichment born out of a burden to lead children to love God with all their mind and to discover the passionate pursuit of truth has evolved into a ministry with greater significance for our church and community. The past six months have confirmed our initial step of faith to launch this ministry through the influx of new families to South River and the blossoming of our ministries to parents and children. Recent government decisions concerning our children's education expose the need for sound education based on God's truth.

Headwaters Academy will be a ministry of South River Baptist Church to enrich the education of children to love God with all their mind and to encourage a joyful pursuit of His truth. Headwaters will provide prekindergarten and grade school children with a Christian worldview and Christ-centered education centering on a personal belief in God's Word, a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, a passion for intellectual understanding guided by divine wisdom, an appreciation for strong family, and a love for our Republic. The hearts and minds of children will be trained to draw from modern man's intellectual and spiritual inheritance found in both the Judeo-Christian faith and the Greco-Roman culture. We believe that heritage is evident in the American experiment of self-government under law. We desire to develop within children the intellectual and personal habits and skills upon which responsible, independent, and productive lives are built.

Headwaters Academy can be launched in August 2021. The school will be governed by South River Baptist Church as a ministry of the church. We will identify an advisory board who will work with the Senior Pastor to ensure the success of Headwaters Academy. The school will pursue accreditation in the future. Initially, we envision prekindergarten through 6th grade with the possibility of 7th and 8th grade with sufficient enrollment. Headwaters will be housed in the Family Life Center and modular units in the new parking areas on the master plan.

FAMILY LIFE CENTER RENOVATION AND ADDITION





The Family Life Center is a critical ministry resource for our church. Our primary mission at South River is to glorify God in worship and to make disciples of Jesus Christ. Authentic worship fuels everything we do such as missions, training our minds, caring for our bodies, and reaching our community and countries for Christ. We propose the following renovations and addition in order to prepare our church to minister to increasing numbers in a wider variety of ways in the coming years. One of our greatest challenges at South River is both ample and adequate classroom space for the numerous ministries throughout the week. Our proposal seeks to enable greater flexibility in how space is used by having fixed and moveable walls enabling many different configurations to allow gatherings of varying sizes, creating new classrooms on a second floor in the FLC, and building an addition dedicated to children's ministry with a large venue. We also can house an expanded prekindergarten ministry in this area throughout the week.
