

Why Carry a Bible to Church?

This is something we encourage our students to do every time they come to church. I always say in our videos "Bring a Bible and bring a friend" and the majority of them bring their Bible and some bring friends. The below is something I borrowed from an online article titled "Why Carry a Bible to Church". May we treat the handling and reading of the Bible greater than we do our hobbies, phones, or anything else that pulls our time away from hiding His Word in our hearts.

- Carrying the Word of God serves as a testimony to others. When believers reverently carry the Bible they send a message - God's Word is the central thing in our worship! Not the
- music or the fellowship. We gather to hear God's truth and that truth is found in the Word of God. This example should be observed by our children and learned in youth.
- Carrying the Word of God prevents distraction. The Bible is on my phone, my iPad, and my computer. It is wonderful that we can access the Word of God anywhere we go. Why not just use those devices in the worship service? Too many distractions. Text messages, emails, Facebook posts, and a host of other things constantly clamor for attention. We hear those messages enough. When we come



Carrying the Word of God encourages personal Bible study. I believe this is the most important reason. People need to get into the Word of God for themselves. When we have our own copy of the Scriptures, we can mark that Bible for future reference and personal study. It is interesting that the word "Bible" literally means books. Call me old-fashioned but I still love the feel of the actual book in my hand - my Bible. Each person having their own copy encourages them to follow along as the Pastor preaches and continue that study long after the church service concludes.

There is no doubt that it is more important to carry God's Word in your heart than in your hand. Yet when the Scriptures are not near at hand they are rarely being intentionally placed in the







MEN'S BIBLE STUDY

Instead of teaching men how to hone their aggressive traits, modern society tells us to "smash the patriarchy." Modern churches offer the meek servant-leader as the only model for manliness. In most contexts today, men who display signs of independence are simply shown the door.

This leaves most young men lost. They don't know what to do or how to improve, so they watch Jordan Peterson clips on YouTube in an attempt to grow in their masculinity and sense of mission. In this book, Michael Foster and Bnonn Tennant

remind men that their natural aggressive instincts are gifts from God that are meant to be used for the kingdom. Men are supposed to found households, join brotherhoods, and work towards a mission.

God made men to be strong and to be risk-takers. This is a feature, not a bug. It's Good to Be A Man is a handbook for men showing where you are and how to find out where you should be going. Foster and Tennant will show you why it is good to be a man.


