### FROM THE PASTOR

Dear South River Church Family,

How do I make my life count! Life is precious, a gift from God, which shouldn't be squandered. Time is that commodity that can't be replenished. So, we need to make the most of each day God gives us. Are you making the most of your life?

The way to ensure my life counts is to consider the prayer Moses prayed to God in Psalm 90:15-16. Moses prayed for God to reveal the work for His servant. God has a purpose for every believer! There is a place where we can serve God and advance His kingdom, proclaim His truth, and reveal the power of grace to change someone's life. Our life will count when we find the place God wants us to serve and get to it.


Proverbs 31:30

Her love, teaching, gentle instruction, and countless prayers helped shape me into the man I have become. I long for another kiss and hug from her. But for now, I must settle for the memories we share until we meet again in heaven. ### **Seeking Worshipers**

John4:23 - But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

As the pastor who seeks to facilitate corporate worship, I am happy that the Father takes the pressure off of me in one sense. The truth is that Father God is seeking for worshipers. That is His job description, not mine! He expects me to encourage, exhort, challenge, inspire, educate and inform the body to worship both as a body together, but also individually throughout the week. Biblical forms of worship involve the Word of God, prayer, meditation, singing, shouting, playing instruments, crying, praising, raising hands, kneeling, laying prostrate before Him, etc. Jesus is saying here that the form is not as important as the heart attitude. We must worship in spirit and truth - spiritually (not in the selfishness of our flesh, our own desires as the main goal) and honestly (be honest with God and others about who you are). Ask yourself, "Am I the worshiper that Father God is seeking?





Instead of teaching men how to hone their aggressive traits, modern society tells us to "smash the patriarchy." Modern churches offer the meek servant-leader as the only model for manliness. In most contexts today, men who display signs of independence are simply shown the door.

This leaves most young men lost. They don't know what to do or how to improve, so they watch Jordan Peterson clips on YouTube in an attempt to grow in their masculinity and sense of mission. In this book, Michael Foster and Bnonn Tennant

remind men that their natural aggressive instincts are gifts from God that are meant to be used for the kingdom. Men are supposed to found households, join brotherhoods, and work towards a mission.

God made men to be strong and to be risk-takers. This is a feature, not a bug. It's Good to Be A Man is a handbook for men showing where you are and how to find out where you should be going. Foster and Tennant will show you why it is good to be a man.


