
DEEP & WIDE STUDENT MINISTRY

As a pastor we are always praying for God to show the fruits of our labor and God has done that through several posts or text messages these past few weeks. Below is one example that was posted on Facebook by one of our GROW students and it's regarding the song that we will be learning and singing about the Goodness of our God. Church, we NEED to GROW in our walk each day,



may that be the desires of each of us. GROWing is not easy but it's rewarding!



This is a truly profound and moving song that beautifully captures the essence of our relationship with God. Its lyrics express a deep sense of awe and reverence for the goodness and grace of our Heavenly Father. The song reminds us of His majesty, love, and the profound sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

As we listen to the lyrics, we are drawn into a contemplative space where we reflect on the immeasurable love and mercy of God. It's a reminder that despite our flaws and shortcomings, we are welcomed into His presence with open arms and with the promise of acceptance. The chorus, with its repetition of "You are good, You are good," reinforces the fundamental truth of God's nature, which is goodness itself.

The song also highlights the response that this recognition of God's goodness should evoke in us — a desire to surrender our lives completely to Him, to worship and adore Him unreservedly. He is the King that is in need of nothing, but he's so gracious we ought to praise and worship Him with our everything. 

We Worship the LORD For Who He is

Psalm 103:1-5 - Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! 2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: 3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, 4 Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, 5 Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

This psalm of David recognizes the goodness and blessings of God. Like the old gospel song says to count your many blessings. Are there days you just get down in the mouth about the circumstances around you? All of us do! When that happens to you, stop and begin to ponder on the goodness of God in your life - all the wonderful blessings He gives.

Let's make a list with David. 1. God forgives ALL my iniquities. The One who is HOLY forgives my intentional sin, the deepest and darkest things I have thought and acted upon. This is God's most important blessing to us, but don't pass over it quickly. 2. He heals all my diseases (physical, spiritual, emotional, mental). I trust you know many things from which God has given you healing, not just physical. 3. He redeems me from destruction. He has purchased my safety from eternal destruction through the precious blood of Christ! 4. He places His love and mercy on my head. 5. He feeds me good-tasting things that strengthen, rejuvenate and restore me. When we look at life from this perspective, how can we not worship and bring ultimate praise to the One Who is the source of all our blessings. We thank Him for the blessing, but we worship him for Who He is - Forgiver, Healer, Redeemer, Mercy Giver, The One Who alone satisfies!
