



Quenching the Spirit of God

1 Thessalonians 5:19-21 - "19 Do not quench the Spirit. 20 Do not despise prophecies. 21 Test all things; hold fast what is good."

This passage in First Thessalonians features a series of rapid-fire commands from the Lord. In fact, these commands all mean to STOP DOING THIS. In other words, it speaks to something the church is doing and they are commanded to STOP IT. It is signficant that all these commands carry a major emphasis, as if God raises His voice as He speaks. "Stop quenching the Spirit!" Scripture often pictures Holy Spirit like a fire (Mt 3:11, Lk 3:16-17, Ac 2:3-4, Ac 4:31, Ex 3:2, Is 4:4). What Paul is saying here (under the God-breathed nature of scipture) is stop dousing out, extinguishing, suppressing or stifling the work of Holy Spirit? So, let's ask some questions of ourselves and how our answers impact the church and our worship.

- 1. Do my thoughts and attitudes toward excitement in a new believer quench the work of Holy Spirit?
- 2. Does my critical spirit toward those who openly express praise quench Holy Spirit?
- 3. Does my attitude toward the length of a worship service or the message quench Holy Spirit?
- 4. Does my reluctance or refusal to pray at the altar quench Holy Spirit?

We need to be careful when we see Holy Spirit working in someone's life, in a time of corporate worship, or even in our own hearts as He speaks to us, that we do not throw a bucket of cold water on the work of Holy Spirit. We are not immune or unique to quenching the Spirit. If God told the Thessalonian church to stop these things, we are commanded the same.


