


DEEP & WIDE STUDENT MINISTRY

Extravagant Worship

John 12:1-3 - "Then, six days before the Passover, Jesus came to Bethany, where Lazarus was who had been dead, whom He had raised from the dead. 2 There they made Him a supper; and Martha served, but Lazarus was one of those who sat at the table with Him. 3 Then Mary took a pound of very costly oil of spikenard, anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped His feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the oil."

Of course, most of us know this event in the life of our Lord Jesus. Mary & Martha were hosting a party in honor of Jesus in their home. This is after Lazarus had been raised from the dead, so you can imagine the gratefulness these sisters wished to express toward Jesus. The box of spikenard spices and ointment likely represent Mary's life savings, roughly equivalent to an average man's yearly wages. This is a highly extravagant sacrifice of worship given from a pure heart of devotion. Mary is in the place where she is often found, at the feet of Jesus! Don't read anything untoward as she wipes Jesus' feet with her hair. It expresses humility and reverence.

The song, "Broken and Spilled Out" expresses such reverence like this: "Broken and spilled out, just for love of You, Jesus. My most precious treasure lavished on Thee. Broken and spilled out, and poured at Your feet. In sweet abandon, let me be spilled out and used up for Thee."

- 1. Have I ever worshipped Jesus through a gift of utter extravagance that made no sense to others?
- 2. If not, would I be willing to do so out of pure devotion to my Savior, regardless of what others think?


