Looking Back . . .

We just completed our first year of Grow in our Student Ministry area. 28 weeks of growing through the Word of God so that we can be "like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper." We had the opportunity to teach the Attributes of God, pictures of Jesus through the Old Testament and several Disciplines of the Faith. With each of the 28 lessons we also taught a Hymn/Worship Song that helps the student to



understand why we should be aware of what we sing unto The Lord. In the Fall, we looked at God is Holy, Sovereign, Love, Good, Glorious, Light, Eternal, Omnipresent, Incomprehensible, Omniscient, Omnipotent, and Immutable. After Christmas we taught Jesus is the Firstborn Over All Creation, The Serpent Crusher, The Ark and The Door, One through Whom the World is Blessed, Lamb God has Provided, Stairway to Heaven, Betrayed and the Savior, Deliverer, Passover Lamb, Rock Moses Struck, Mediator and Tabernacle. We also taught a Discipline of the Faith every 4th Sunday and they were Bible Study, The Purpose of Tithing, Prayer and Worship. Each student that attended received a Challenge Coin, encouraging them to never stop growing in their walk with Christ. We start back September 8th, don't miss the opportunity to GROW.




