

Worship Before Serving

Luke 10:38-42

38 Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. 39 And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. 40 But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." 41 And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. 42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

We know this story, but let's look at some lessons. Martha is the hostess, but she is drawn away from enjoying Jesus' presence by the burden of her duties. She seems to be more bothered with not having help, than not hearing Jesus' teaching. In contrast, Mary appears to be a disciple of Jesus, because sitting at the master's feet is what characterizes true disciples. Jesus tells Martha that Mary has chosen the part which is better - her worship takes precedence over tending to cares in this world, even necessary cares. For a disciple, learning and obedience takes first place. Human needs are real, but the most important need is personal worship. Are you a disciple or are you distracted?

- 1. Am I taking time to worship and listen/hear Jesus speak before I serve Him?
- 2. If I am hearing Him speak, am I then obeying what He has said to take action?


