Colossians 3:12-17

12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Can you hear the tone of grace and goodness in these verses? Grace is what we pass on to others when we remember we have been the receipients of ultimate graciousness from God. Verse 15 bears the idea that when we fail to have peace, it is the Spirit that blows the whistle on us that something is wrong. Notice God calls us to build one another up with our songs of praise from right hearts, All of this is for the glory of the Lord Jesus!




