#### **MISSIONS MINISTRY**

#### Hot Meal and the Gospel

Are the smiles and stories created around a cooker and a warm chicken plate worth it? Yes, through the "Behemoth" cooker and warm chicken plate we had the opportunity to have multiple Gospel conversations. We were able to encourage and remind those we served that there are those that care both for their physical need but most importantly their spiritual needs. Sure, most mornings started way before the chickens got up but to know that someone hasn't had a hot meal for 10 days it was worth it. We had the chance to serve around 8,500 meals in 11 days. We partnered with churches that were in the areas impacted by

Helene. We served food at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Hendersonville, Pheonix Baptist Church in Lansing, French Broad Baptist Church in Hendersonville, The Bridge Church in Hendersonville sent us to Madison County Sherriff's Office, Union Grove Baptist Church in Lenior, and The Place Fellowship Church in Fairview. During these trips we also were able to meet the needs that each church was presented with and these needs changed daily. Our first trip up the mountain we delivered box truck of supplies along with 2,000 pounds of fresh chicken to East Fork Baptist Church in Canton. Other supplies delivered to these areas were food, laundry detergent, propane tanks, diapers, wipes, little buddy heaters, blankets, coats, and stuffed animals. Our efforts will continue, and the needs of those affected

by the hurricane will continue to change. The weeks to come will entail some cooking but most of the work will be helping those in the rebuilding process. None of this would have been possible without the doors that God continues to open, the support of the church and those that were back home getting things prepared for the next day's journey.




