### Need the Word and Context!

Each Monday and Wednesday I have the opportunity to teach Bible to the Middle and High School students at Headwaters. The topic currently being taught is Hermeneutics or basically how to properly interpret the Bible.

Each class is started with a time of reading God's Word and Journaling the things that we see during our Observation, which leads us to a proper Interpretation and then we **APPLY** it to our lives. The students also take notes throughout the class.

At the end of the 9 weeks, I collected their journals just to make sure everyone was on track. As I was turning through one of the journals the picture that is attached caught my eyes.

One of the notes stated "Don't just read the Bible on Sunday, Read it every day! You need to!!" and the other "Do Not take The Bible Out of context!!!" Wow, these are two statements that are true for every believer. Joshua 1:8 says that we should meditate on the WORD day and night.

CON text !!!

### We NEED to be in the Word daily.

2 Timothy 2:15 says we should study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be Max 1. Why is the author certain | Particular ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. The way we handle the Word and teach the Word matters.

Let's start reading the Word daily because we **NEED** it and by doing so we have a better chance of keeping it in CONTEXT!

### **DEEP & WIDE YOUTH MINISTRY**

I posed the question a few weeks ago: What is the primary goal of evangelism?

To answer this question, let's look at Matt 28:18-20.

"18 Then Jesus came up and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

### Now read 1 Cor 3:6-7.

"6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God caused it to grow. 7 So neither the one who plants counts for anything, nor the one who waters, but God who causes the growth."

- According to Matthew, we are commanded, as we go through life, to make disciples.
- This includes baptizing them and teaching them to obey Jesus.
- How does Paul in 1 Cor inform us of how this process works?

Paul says this to the Corinthian church: I planted the gospel, Apollos did some more work with the gospel, but ultimately it was God who saved, who caused it to burst forth in the heart.

So, according to these texts, our goal in evangelism is to glorify God by proclaiming the glorious announcement of the victory and kingdom of our Savior King, Jesus. Also known as, the Gospel.

Once this proclamation takes place, we leave the rest up to the Lord. If we have glorified Him through a faithful proclamation of the Gospel, then we have done all we can. If it so pleases Him to bring conversion, we then continue by baptizing and teaching them to obey Jesus.

Thank the Lord that conversion is not left up to us! If it were, no one would be saved!

Evangelism is not a contradiction to God's sovereignty in saving. In fact, God has purposed that salvation won't happen without the proclamation of the Gospel! Evangelism is necessary for the salvation of God's people. God's plan won't be thwarted to save all he desires! Did you know the gospel won't fail? Joyfully read Rev 7:9-10 with me.

### 9 After these things I looked, and here was an enormous crowd that no one could count, made up of persons from every nation, tribe, people, and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb dressed in long white robes, and with palm branches in their hands. 10 They were shouting out in a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God, who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

What wonder! The Holy One of Israel has purposed from before the creation of the world to send His Son to purchase/redeem a people from every nation, tribe, people, and language! Listen carefully, the Gospel will not fail!

So South River, let us proclaim. Let us plant, let us water, and most importantly let us leave the weight and responsibility of growing the seed in the soul to the only One who can do it.




