





Below is a great comparison chart that helps us better understand the reason we should be appreciative of Christ great Gift. Take some time and read through Romans 5, take special note of what each ADAM brought to us.

1st Adam

act of sin - vv. 12, 14, 16 offense - vv. 15-18 disobedience - v. 19

2nd Adam - Christ

act of grace – v. 15 act of righteousness – v.18 obedience – v. 19

Physical Results

death on all – vv. 12,14-15,17 life for all – vv.17-18, 21

Moral Results

sin enters for all – v. 12 sin reigns on all – v. 21 grace enters for all – v.15 grace reigns for all – v. 21

#Heavenflag

Legal Results

all made sinners - v. 19 all made righteous - v. 19 judgement for all - v. 18 gift for all - v. 18 condemnation for all - vv.16,18 justification for all - vv. 16, 18

DEEP & WIDE YOUTH MINISTRY

The Local Church, What Is It?

In one of my Realm emails, I posed three questions: "What is the local church? How is it supposed to operate? And why does it matter for you personally?". I intended to answer that here briefly, according to Acts 2:42-47, Acts 4:32-37, Acts 20:29-31, and 1 Cor 12:12-31.

Here are the 3 marks, according to the texts above, that constitute a local church:

The marks of a true local church:

- 1. Consistent agree upon time and day for gathering to koinonia and worship.
- 2. The preaching/teaching of the Word of God/Sound doctrine (Requires a Pastor)
- 3. Right administration of the ordinances (Baptism and The Lord's Supper).

(Koinonia is a special fellowship only Christians can experience within the Body of Christ, this includes and necessitates encouraging, rebuking, exhorting, addressing one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, and most importantly, pointing and addressing one another to Jesus with the Gospel message)

Operating a church in an unbiblical or unwise way can be detrimental to the gospel message in your geographical area because just as the individual Christian affects the reception of the gospel through living a sinful life to those around him, so can a local church by something as simple as elevating the traditions of man over the Word of God.

Consider this quote:

"The universal church "shows up" in local congregations. Yet it should also "show up" in every church's disposition to partner with other churches, even as we see among churches in the New Testament. The New Testament churches shared love and greetings (Rom. 16:16; 1Cor. 16:19; 2Cor. 13:13; etc.). They shared preachers and missionaries (2Cor. 8:18; 3 John 5-6a). They supported one another financially with joy and thanksgiving (Rom. 15:25–26; 2 Cor. 8:1–2). They imitated one another in Christian living (1Thes. 1:7; 2:14; 2Thes. 1:4). They cared for one another financially (1Cor. 16:1–3; 2Cor. 8:24). They prayed for one another (Eph. 6:18). And more." – Jonathan Leeman.

This last quote is very radical. Most churches today do not operate like this, but this is how the early church operated. The local church is not called to autonomy but to unity and partnership as one part, pointing to the whole for the glory of God. This is hard to do and requires much wisdom due to the existence of unbiblical churches, but this must not stop us from pressing on to do so.

What Grows In Your Child's Heart?

How much have you thought of your child's heart lately? Have you thought about how their heart is like a garden in which case, if bad seeds are allowed to germinate they can grow up into some pretty ugly characteristics in later years? I recently read an article titled "Gardening My Child's Heart" from Answers in Genesis and I encourage you to go read it.

Maybe you're reading this and your child is in prek, or maybe you're reading this and your kid is in 5th grade on the upper end of childhood. Regardless of their age, however, their heart is much like a garden and God has placed you in their lives as the gardener. The seeds that cause problems can come into your home in all different ways. Social media, You'Tube, Children's games on smartphones, and more generally, the internet at large. Not to mention the movies, shows or other types of entertainment that are designed to make your children disrespectful and unruly most of the time. If you have watched any amount of Disney teen shows or anything like that you quickly see there is a theme of children being disrespectful, dishonoring, sassy, and rude to their parents or the other authorities in their life such as teachers and coaches. But there is certainly no encouragement to be submissive to authority and certainly no effort to make such character traits appealing to young minds. I would like to consider what Solomon encouraged parents to do:

"Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he is old he will not depart from it." -Proverbs 22:6

This "training" he speaks of encompasses a great amount of responsibility. This most certainly includes guarding your young one's heart, being mindful of what can get in, and helping them process things through a Biblical worldview. Because Solomon would also say "foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child," and it's our job to help unravel that in a Biblical, loving way.

I say all this to encourage you as parents to be alert and to be proactive about what comes into your little one's heart through all the channels from the outside world. They only have one and Satan would love nothing more than to gain a foothold in their lives. Your precious child's heart is like a garden, what are you allowing to grow there?




