RIPPLEKIDZ MINISTRY

In studying the story of Joseph, I came to a particular section that made me realize something: Joseph clearly understood God's redemptive power. After he was taken out of prison, interpreted the Pharaoh's dreams, and was made ruler over Egypt, God blessed him and his wife with two sons during the seven years of plenty in Egypt. He will even see this when his brothers appear in Egypt to buy food from him. Now the circumstances in which a child was born had great effects on what the child would be named. So the Bible tells us,

Joseph named the firstborn Manasseh, "For," he said, "God has made me forget all my trouble and all my father's household." He named the second Ephraim, "For," he said, "God has made me fruitful in the land of my affliction." Genesis 41:51-52

For the believer, this world is the land of our affliction. But we have the promise that one day God will cause us to forget all our troubles. We have been given hope that one day God will make all things new, and that even now, He is working all things out for our good. It would do us well to imitate Joseph in this way. He understood the New Testament principle that declares God will wipe away every tear, right every wrong, and that the old things will one day pass away and the new will be our forever reality Revelation 21:4.






